About the Grace Church Choir School

The Choir School Program of Grace Church is a musical and educational outreach of Grace Church in Newark, under the leadership of Father Brent Bates, our Rector. Our program is based on the idea that all children are able to sing, given encouragement and instruction. We offer free music education and performance opportunities for youth, grade 3 through high school.


In our tuition-free program, we accept children from Newark and surrounding towns, all economic circumstances and all faith traditions—all are welcome. Choristers need not be members of Grace Church; they must only agree to rehearse and perform as scheduled. Our choristers come from a variety of communities and schools, including public schools, charter schools, and homeschooling programs. Our choristers represent a wide range of cultural communities, and from many faith traditions.

Joining the Choir School

- Children may join at any time;

- No prior training or experience is expected or required;
- The program is offered at no cost to participating families who commit to the choir schedule;
- Children of any religious affiliation, or no affiliation, are welcome;
- Perfect attendance at rehearsals and all regularly scheduled services and concerts is expected.

In addition to singing on Sunday mornings, our choristers joined choirs from St. Paul's in Englewood, Grace Church in Haddonfield, Holy Spirit in Lebanon, Calvary in Summit, and St. John's in Somerville for an Evensong celebrating the Epiphany on Sunday, January 7, under the leadership of Ms. Diane Caruso, Mr. Evan Cogswell, Mr. Mark Trautman, and Ms. Giulia Utz. We joined the St. Paul's in Englewood Choir to sing Evensong on the Day of Pentecost, May 19, under the direction of Mr. Trautman and organist Dr. Andrew Moore. We have also begun to offer piano lessons again on a regular basis.

We pray *A Chorister's Prayer* at the beginning of each rehearsal. Instruction encompasses aural training, sightreading, music theory, music history, and performance etiquette. Choristers also learn the Liturgical Year, prayers, Bible passages, and more. We name one thing that we are thankful for in our lives at the end of each rehearsal.

Through rehearsals, services, travel, and concerts, the choristers nurture lifelong friendships, experiences and memories during their time in the program, developing an extraordinary capacity for time management, leadership, and team building. These skills are profoundly important for their personal growth and transferable to their academic and professional careers.

Fundraising

The Chorister Program has received three generous grants this year! Christ Church in Short Hills Outreach Committee awarded \$2,500; the Turrell Fund awarded \$5,000; the Marge Christie Fund of the Diocese of Newark awarded \$5,000 and ACTS/VIM awarded us \$15,000. These generous awards help us to grow and maintain our vital







ministry of music, community, formation, and development for our young people, and we are most grateful!

Summer Camp 2024

Choristers will participate in the Diocese of New Jersey Summer Choir Camp in Cape May, July 14-18. The choristers stay at Holiday House of the Girl's Friendly Society of the Diocese of Pennsylvania and rehearse and sing Evensong at the Church of the Advent.
